1. Location set-up (KoBoToolbox users only)

If you're conducting the survey in KoBoToolbox, you'll need to update the location choice-list for country, region, town etc, to be relevant for your local context. The table below helps you to keep track of which locations you want to have available to choose from. You can add as many rows to the table as you need. Some other questions to consider are:

- Will you have a pre-entered list of communities to choose from?
- Will you allow a free-text open-response to allow data collectors to type in the community name if the community isn't in the list?
- Will you collect GPS points for each interview location?

3. Programme involvement

There is a series of questions in the first section of the questionnaire about 'Programme involvement', such as:

- Have you been involved with this church and community transformation (CCT) process/programme in the last six months?
- What has been the most significant impact of the CCT process in your life?

These questions assume that yours is a CCT programme, but if that's not the case, you can update these questions to refer to your programme type/project name.
