

# Glossary

<b>brainstorm</b>	to state what immediately comes to mind about an issue
<b>CD-ROM</b>	compact disc storing information that can be read on a computer
<b>energisers</b>	short games or activities to refresh people when they are tired
<b>illustrations</b>	pictures, such as those found on each double page of a PILLARS Guide
<b>mentoring</b>	advising, training, supporting someone as they develop new skills
<b>NGO</b>	non-governmental organisation
<b>peer mentoring</b>	advising, training, supporting someone with the same status or role
<b>PILLARS</b>	Partnership In Local Language ResourceS
<b>pilot</b>	test, trial period
<b>stimulus</b>	incentive, motivating factor
<b>surveyor</b>	someone who carefully analyses a situation or people's viewpoints
<b>syllabus</b>	subjects in a course of study or teaching
<b>text</b>	written material, such as that found on each double page of a PILLARS Guide
<b>theoretical</b>	concerned with theory rather than practice
<b>visual aids</b>	objects that can be used to illustrate or teach something
